Falls Church AAUW's Educational Equity Scholarships are intended to empower young women in our community who are determined to succeed in college. In accordance with AAUW's focus on education for women and girls, these scholarships support graduating senior girls with limited financial means to attend college and pursue their educational goals. Young people from public high schools in the Falls Church area who have demonstrated scholastic achievement and financial need are selected annually through a competitive process. Academic progress, leadership potential, work ethic, and school and/or community participation are considered. The number and amount of awards are based on the funds available, the number of qualified applicants, and the financial need of applicants. Scholarships are paid to the university and may be applied by the university toward tuition, room and board, books, and other educational expenses.

- Send a copy of your **Financial Form (FAFSA).** We prefer that you submit it electronically. You may also send the completed FAFSA by mail to Mary Youman, 4419 18th Street North, Arlington, VA 22207-2311.
- Give the **Recommendation Forms to two adults** who know you well. At least one Recommendation must be from a school staff member. Recommendations must be sent by mail to Mary Youman, 4419 18th Street North, Arlington, VA 22207-2311. Recommendations may not be sent electronically. (Recommendations sent electronically *will not* be accepted.)
- Ask your high school guidance office to mail an **official high school transcript** to Mary Youman, 4419 18th Street North, Arlington, VA 22207-2311. Your official high school transcript must be sent by mail, and may not be sent electronically. (Official high school transcripts sent electronically *will not* be accepted.)
